With a distinctly Australian influence, enjoy wide open spaces in a huge cockpit with targa seats that surround the BBQ, all under protective shading. Sailing is taken seriously with a helm that works for the crew, featuring Seawind’s trademark twin steering for outstanding visibility, fingertip controls

of all lines that are fed back to the cockpit where the crew remain protected from the elements making the Seawind 1000XL a fantastic shorthanded boat to sail.

The Seawind 1000XL is a versatile boat, ideal for chartering, weekend getaways, cruising the coastline or even ocean

passages, with many owners having sailed throughout the Pacific Ocean including to destinations such as New Zealand, Fiji, New Caledonia and more. Others have explored the American coastlines north to Canada & Alaska, and south to Mexico, Brazil and beyond.

The Seawind 1000 has undergone several transforming refinements since it was originally launched and won Australian Sailboat of the Year. Since then around 200 boats have been built and are sailing all over the world. The latest exciting refinement is the addition of the XL Transom Extension, adding an additional 850mm in waterline length.

This improvement has resulted in an array of benefits including increased overall performance under sail & power and improved riding qualities. Large steps allow for easy boarding, while the open inboard profile accommodates boarding from a dinghy.

Moving around the Seawind 1000XL is easy and safe with large open deck areas and wide walkways onto the forward deck. The large opening saloon windows not only allow for excellent variable ventilation, they also allow the crew to communicate between the helm to the foredeck. This makes anchoring very efficient and trouble free. All of the best seating options are already considered including the helm, targa, cockpit and bow.

Get a different perspective from the bow seats or swim, snorkel and dive from the forward swim ladder. This is possible only due to the shallow draft of the Seawind 1000XL which even allows you to even nudge the boat onto a gentle beach for crew to disembark via this ladder.

A combined saloon and cockpit provides unparalleled living space where it's needed most. Sheltered by a reinforced fibreglass hardtop, the Seawind 1000XL saloon ensures the crew are comfortable and protected from the elements while creating an amazing living platform complete with a large saloon table that converts into a king-sized day bed. It

quickly becomes apparent onboard that this is a very social boat designed to enjoy the world around you rather than being forced down below.

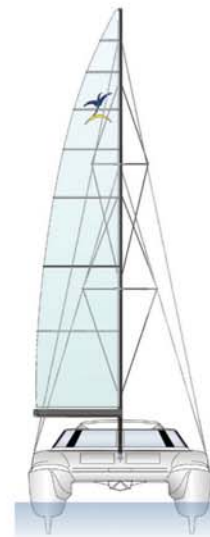
A spacious galley provides large working area, large tabletops plus wide windows with brilliant visibility and ventilation.

Accommodating up to 8-10 people overnight, there are two substantial double cabins with two additional 3/4 double V-berths, complemented by a generous shared head / shower.

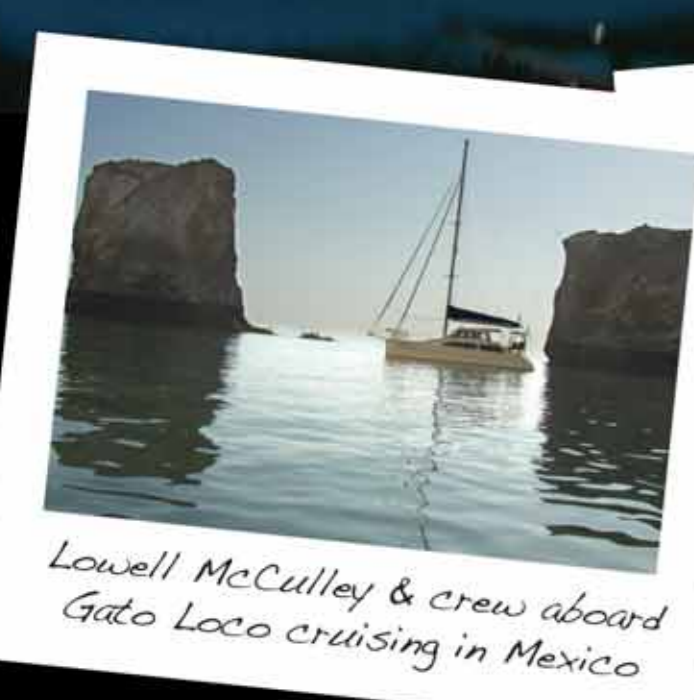

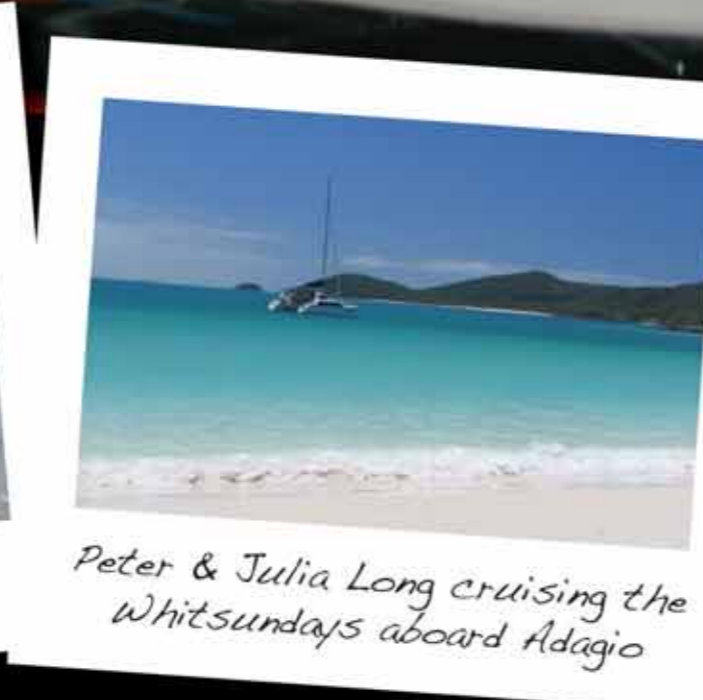

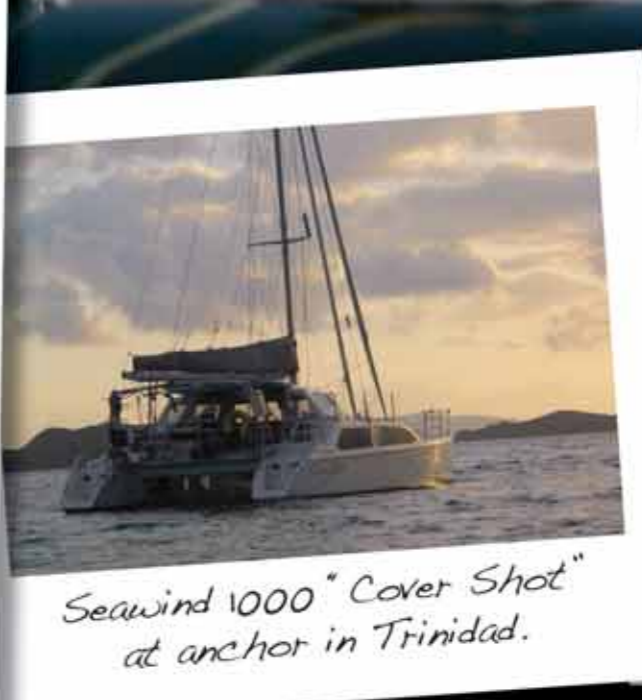
